- ・ Part 2：応答リスニング問題（質問のあとに英文を 3 つ聞いて、正しい返答のものを選ぶ）
- ・ Part 3：会話リスニング問題（短い会話か語りを聞いて、問題用紙の質問に答える）
- ・ Part 4：文法筆記問題（英文のブランクに入る正しい語句を選ぶ）
- ・ Part 5：読解筆記問題（短い英文の文書を読み、問題用紙の質問に答える）

●課題 PDF ファイルについて

第 2 回課題用の PDF ファイルは全部で 13 ページです。最初の 1 ページ目が白紙になっている場合がありますが、気にしなくても大丈夫です。

●課題内容（筆記問題のみ）

PDF ファイルの 3 ページ目から問題があります。今回の課題の問題は、実際のサンプルテストを利用していますが、写真問題の形式は少し変えています。

ブランクに入る正しい語句を 4 つの選択肢から一つ選ぶ。

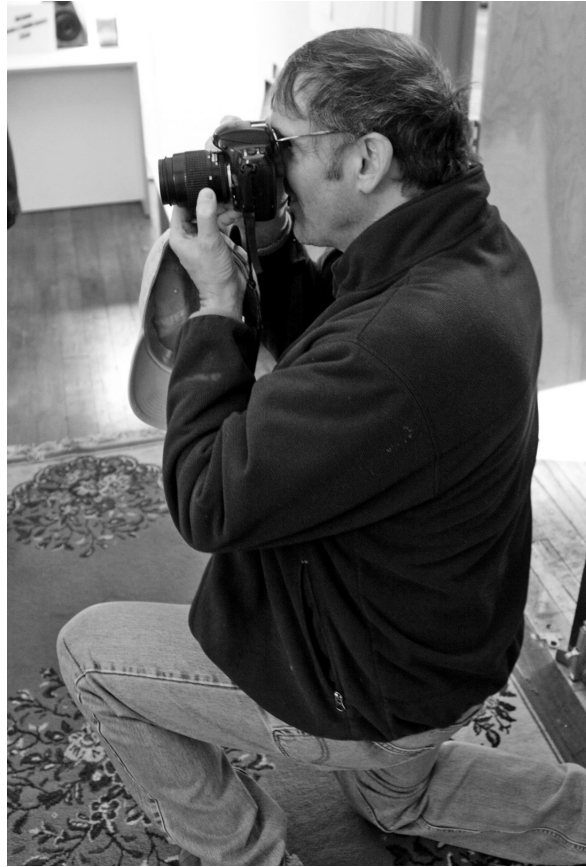
・ 読解筆記問題（問題番号 81～91）

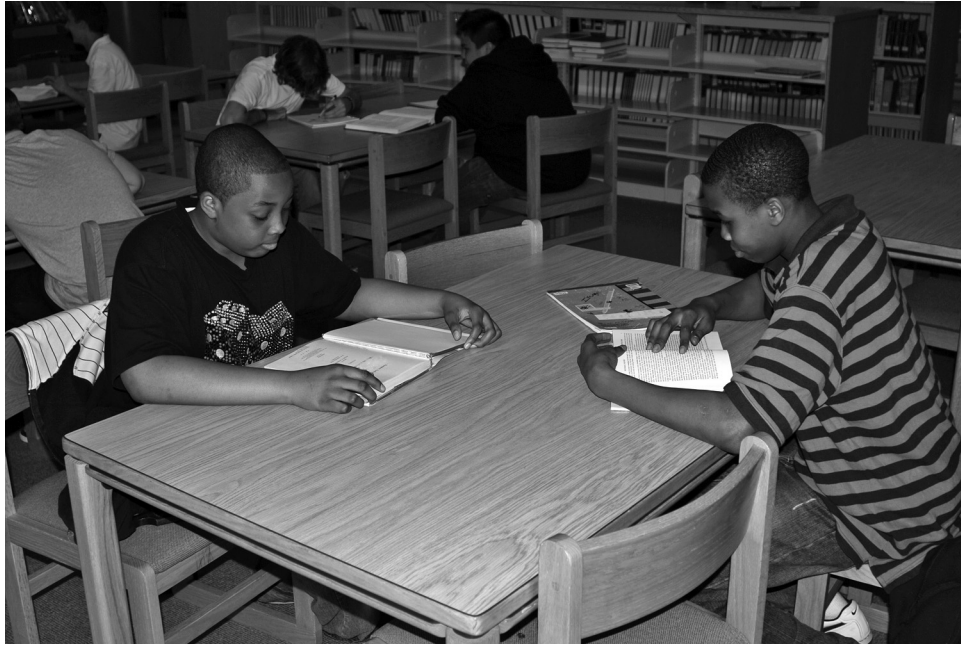

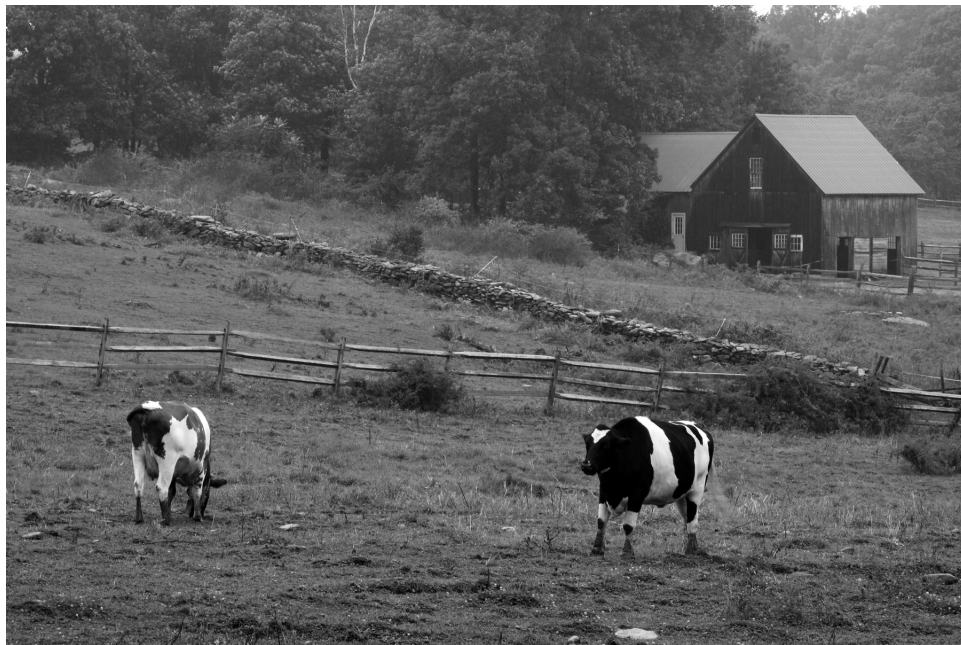

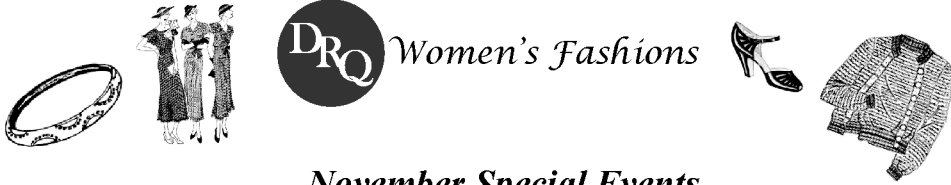
